Energy upgrades for Violet Town Bush Nursing Centre

The Violet Town Bush Nursing Centre was looking to reduce their energy costs, while minimising initial up-front investments.

Through a local accredited provider, who worked closely with them to understand their individual needs, the Centre undertook energy-efficiency upgrades and replaced old and inefficient lighting with new LED lights.

The new lighting covered 64 bedrooms, communal spaces, kitchens and office areas.

Due to Victorian Energy Upgrades, the Centre saved 90 per cent on up-front investment costs.

Through their dramatic reduction in energy use, the Centre is now saving more than \$5,000 off their annual energy bills.
